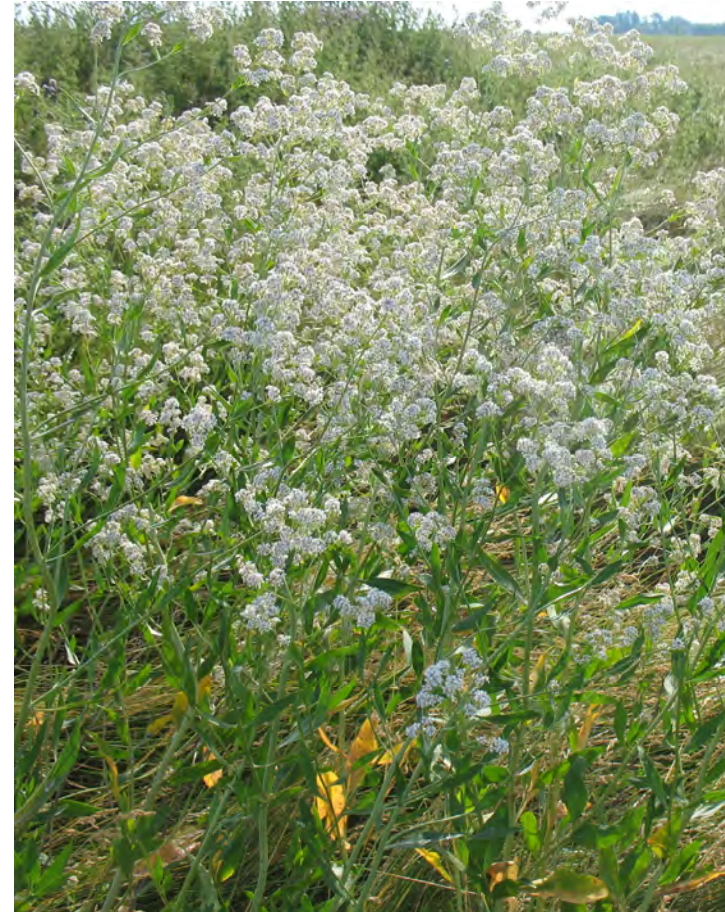


Pepper-grass, broad-leaved
Lepidium latifolium
Brassicaceae (Mustard Family)

Noxious



- . **Life cycle:** Perennial.
- . **Root:** Deep spreading roots.
- . **Leaves:** Bright green to gray green, broadest at base and tapering to pointed tip, with prominent whitish mid-vein. Basal leaves are up to 40cm long and 10cm wide with long stalks, covered with a waxy layer. Stem leaves smaller with smaller stalks, alternate, and do not clasp stem.
- . **Stems:** 30-90cm tall but can be up to 1.5m tall.
- . **Flower:** Small, less than 1cm wide with four white petals, and are borne in dense, rounded clusters on terminal branches.
- . **Seed/Fruit:** Flat, rounded, slightly hairy, 2-3mm long, reddish brown capsule contains two tiny seeds.
