## Thistle, Plumeless Carduus acanthoides Asteraceae (Sunflower Family)

- Information: May also be called Bristly Thistle, may be confused with native thistles.
- Life Cycle: Herbaceous biennial, or winter annual. Rosette leaves in the first years growth, flowers in the second.
- **Root:** Taproot, large and fleshy.
- Leaves: Clasping, alternately arranged on the stem, spines along edge and at leaf tip, hairy, lobed. Rosette leaves are very large.
- Stems: Spines along stem, up to 2m tall.
- Flower: Purple, small, erect, spine tipped bracts, smaller than nodding thistle.
- Seed/Fruits: Spread by seed, pappus attached to seed, wind dispersal.
- Toxicity:
- Control: Hand pull, chemical control before seed set.
