 Funding for this project was trusted 2004. We understand the County is in the process of retaining a new consultant and resolving some fishery issues at this site. Please provide a consultant's proposal as soon as possible.

BF 7760, Ribstone Creek near Ribstone, WSW 2420-43-02-04

 This bridge crossing should be eliminated with the proposed construction at BF6688.

BF 71744, Watercourse near Edgerton, WSW 23-45-03-04

 The struts that were installed in this culvert appear to be working, however there are missing pieces. We suggest you remove the existing struts and re-install new struts as per AIT Standard Drawing S-1620. Funding is not available for strutting of culverts.

BF 7268, Ribstone Creek near Edgerton, SSE 28-44-05-04

- The substructure of this bridge was cored in 2003 and rot was
 discovered in only one spot on the east abutment cap. There are
 no visible signs of distress in the form of crushing or bulging. We
 suggest the County monitor the condition of the caps.
- Moved by Clr. MacKay that the Municipal District of Wainwright No. 61 be authorized to hire Stantec Engineering as our consultants to assist us with proceeding with the BF 75145 and BF 6688 projects. CARRIED
